

Interaction and Visit of NAAC Peer Team to IARI (2nd Day)

In continuation with the previous day visits and interactions, peer team on second day visited to School of Natural Resources Management including divisions of Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry, Water Science & Technology and School of Basic Sciences comprising of Division of Biochemistry and Division of Plant Physiology. Team had a comprehensive interactive session with scientists and then visited the experimental farms. IARI has a huge farm area which is used for various research activities. Peer team also visited various facilities viz. Agricultural Knowledge Management Unit, Phenomics Facility, Phytotron Facility, Animal House, Incinerator Facility and Waste Water Treatment Plant. They also interacted with members of Grievance committee and exchanged their views on grievance related issues. Team also interacted and discussed with anti ragging/prevention of sexual harassment committee.

Later on peer team had an interaction with PG School administrative staff, finance staff and saw e-governance system. Team had a detailed conversation with students and IARI alumni.
