

ICAR-IARI Organized Training on Organic Farming for Farmers of Rajasthan

The Division of Agronomy, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi, in collaboration with ATMA Jodhpur, Rajasthan, Rural Access, and farmer-producer organizations (FPOs) from Jodhpur district, organized a two-day training program on Organic Farming during 26–27 August 2025 at ICAR-IARI, New Delhi. The program aimed to empower 40 farmers from Jodhpur with sustainable agricultural practices to enhance productivity while conserving natural resources. In his inaugural address, Dr. S.S. Rathore, Head, Division of Agronomy, emphasized the vital role of organic farming in building climate-resilient production systems. The training featured 10 expert lectures covering the fundamentals of organic farming, including biofertilizers, integrated nutrient management, crop diversification, and strategies for enhancing farm income through localized resource utilization. During the valedictory session, Dr. R.N. Padaria, Joint Director (Extension), commended the initiative and encouraged farmers to adopt organic farming practices for long-term sustainability and profitability.
