

### Technical information for Pusa Sadabahar of chilli

It produces fruits in cluster. Fruit bearing is upright. Generally 5-8 fruits per cluster. Yield potential is 8.0-10.0 tons/ha during first year. The plants are perennial in nature *i.e.* it can be kept in the same field for 2-3 years however, the yield gets reduced. It is tolerant to leaf curl virus but susceptible to tospovirus.

Plant height is 60.0-80.0 cm. Growth habit is upright. Leaves are dark green and broad.

Under Delhi condition, for *Kharif* crop, sowing is done in June and transplanting in July or early August. First harvesting can be done in last week of September or early October.

For Spring-summer crop, the nursery should be raised in polyhouse during December - January and transplanting is done during First fortnight of February and first harvesting is done in first fortnight of April.
