Response to RTI Appeal No. IAGRI/A/E/26/00008 dated 23/6/2026

Query 1: What is the policy of the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) regarding who can attend the field days that are organised by IARI throughout the year?

Response: ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) organizes field days for different purposes. Majorly, the field days are organized in project villages to show case and promote the technologies among the farmers, entrepreneurs, extension personnel, students, and other interested people. There is no restriction for any stakeholders. The field days are also organized at Institute's experimental farms. Some field days are organised exclusively for the scientific staff and students of ICAR-IARI for scientific review, discussion, and evaluation of ongoing research programmes. These programmes are primarily intended to review project progress, facilitate scientific deliberations, and suggest mid-course corrections, wherever required. These are not public events. However, some field days, besides scientific review, also intend for commercial promotion as well as technology dissemination, where-in seed companies, entrepreneurs, progressive farmers are also invited. For larger participation of stakeholders, visits to experimental farms are organized on some important events like Pusa Krishi Vigyan Mela, Kisan Diwas, etc., which are open for all. Information is given through Pusa Samachar (Institute's YouTube channel), ICAR-IARI website, and other media.

Query 2: Can an individual attend a field day at IARI without an invitation from IARI?

Response: Except for the Field Days organized for scientific review, discussion, and evaluation of ongoing research programmes; an individual can attend other Field Days.

Query 3: If the answer to question 2 is No, then what is the process and timeline to request an invitation from IARI to attend a field day at IARI?

Query 4: Please provide the list of all field days which the IARI will organise within the period of June 15, 2026, to March 31, 2027

Response: No fixed annual schedule is maintained for organising Field Days. These programmes are conducted on a need basis for ongoing in-house research projects and scientific activities. Consequently, no predetermined list of Field Days is available for the requested period. Once the dates are fixed, the information is made available through Pusa Samachar (Institute's YouTube channel), Institute's website.

Query 5: For each field day in the answer to question 4, please mention the name of the division that will organise the field day, the date on which the field day will be organised, and the specific venue within or outside IARI where the field day will be organised.

Response: Some of the field days proposed at village clusters in four districts, adopted by CATAT under its research project, include (1) Machhrauli, Jhatipura, and other villages in Panipat (Haryana); (2) Phulpur, Chholas, and other villages in Gautam Buddha Nagar (UP); (3) Harevali, Ghogha, and other villages in Delhi; and (4) Ishra ka Vas and other villages in

Kotputli-Alwar (Rajasthan). The dates for these programmes have not yet been finalized; however, generally, one field day each for Kharif and Rabi crops will be organized in every village cluster. Field Days will also be organized at ICAR-IARI campus by some Divisions as required for their respective research programmes. However, since there are no fixed dates, the requested information is unavailable.
