INDIAN AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE, New Delhi which is one of the prestigious Institute in the field of Agricultural Research, invites tenders sealed with wax/tape/company seal for entering into Rate Contract for the appointment of Export clearance agent for export of consignments from ICAR-IARI, New Delhi to Vice-Chancellor, Afghanistan National Agricultural Sciences and Technology University (ANASTU), Kandahar, Afghanistan by air as well as sea through the parties dealing with custom clearance. The consignments will contain precious laboratory chemicals.

The tenders are required to submit a certificate with tender that the business dealing of the firm has not been debarred/suspended by any Government/Autonomous Organization.

Only the tenders engaged in customs clearance should submit their tenders. Following jobs shall fall under the scope of the Export clearance.

- 1. Customs clearance of export consignments from New Delhi Airport/Sea port.
 - a) Custom clearance of the export consignment including all the stages of customs clearance as well as packing of equipment
 - b) Any other job in connection with the clearance of goods from customs clearance.

II. Consolidation of the consignments being exported from New Delhi Airport/Sea port

- Complete monitoring and supervision of the movement from the date of order and regular feed back on the progress of order to ICAR-IARI, New Delhi.
- To provide timely information (pre-alert) regarding dispatches and other relevant information to ICAR-IARI, New Delhi.
- To facilitate specialized packing/repacking with all kinds of materials as per the IATA specifications and international packing standards.

- Transportation of projects laboratory chemicals in small and voluminous packages; the laboratory chemicals may belong to categories (a) hazardous and categories (b) non-hazardous and (c) some chemicals may require transportation in package with dry-ice.
- Effective communication through telephone4, tele-fax and e-mail, etc.
- Any other service needed regarding export from time to time.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The tender must be sent in sealed cover. The cover should be sealed with sealing wax/tape/company seal and super scribed with "Tender for entering into rate contract for appointment of consolidation-cum-custom clearance agent indicating for export of items/equipment from ICAR-IARI, New Delhi to Vice-Chancellor, Afghanistan National Agricultural Sciences and Technology University (ANASTU), Kandahar, Afghanistan Tender No. 41-52/18-19/ANASTU/PP/, it should be addressed to the Director, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi-110012 and delivered to Division of Plant Pathology, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi-110012.
- 2. Formats for quoting the rates are attached. The rates must be quoted as per the enclosed two formats only in the following manner apart from furnishing the check-list (enclosed format):
 - (a) Airfreight/Sea Freight Charges: The forwarders must charge most competitive air freight charges/sea freight charges including fuel surcharges, war surcharges, security surcharges and DGR fee/Dangerous & Perishable goods, if any, shall be paid proportionately at actual provided the same is charged by the carrier (Air Company) and shown separately MAWB/B.l. The party has to submit a clean copy of MAWB (importer/customer copy) in support of the above charges along with the bills of payment.
- 3. Forwarder will be responsible for the safety of the cargo in all circumstances and handling complete and proper papers.
- 4. Freight charges will be paid in India in Indian Rupees only as per our agreement/contact after receipt of consignment at destination.
- 5. Pre-shipment advises must be intimated well in advance. A weekly statement showing consignments shipped during last week and the proposed shipment during the next week should be submitted invariable.
- 6. List of documents required for clearance/reimbursement of bill must be mentioned specifically.

- 7. Tenderer must enclose the photocopies of (1) Valid permanent customs licenses as CHA in the name of the bidder having five year experience in export/import, failing which tender will not be considered. (2) A valid certificate of IATA membership not less than five years.
- 8. Tender must be Accompanied with EMD of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) in the shape of demand draft/PO/Bank Guarantee/FDR of Commercial Bank to be drawn in favour of Director, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi. The tender received without EMD shall not be considered and will be summarily rejected, which may please be noted. The EMD of unsuccessful tenders would be refunded on finalization of the contract. Exemption of MSE is allowed subject to production of valid exemption certificate through MSE.
- 9. The successful tenders will have to submit a DD/Pay Order/FDR/Bank Guarantee of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two Lakhs only) from a commercial bank as security, which should be valid at least for 14 months (One year of contract + 60 days) from the date of contract. The same security money will be refunded/returned after completion of also contractual obligations. However, the Director, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi will have the discretion to order for the forfeiture of deposit for any breach of contract.
- 10. The successful bidder shall handle sophisticated and valuable consignment, hence the bidder shall have to furnish a fidelity guarantee bond for an amount of Rs.10.00 Lakhs (Rs.Ten Lakhs only) in favour of Director, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi to safeguard the interest of ICAR-IARI in the event of any loss to ICAR-IARI due to any act of omission and commission by the firm.
- 11. The Director, ICAR-IARI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders received, without assigning any reason.
- 12. The successful tenderer will have to give an undertaking that no consignment of ICAR-IARI will be detained/withheld by them before or after the clearance under any circumstances.
- 13. The Director, ICAR-IARI, New Delhi reserves the right to terminate the contract on one month's prior notice at any time on finding the service unsatisfactory or on breach of contract.
- 14. Work will be awarded to a party who shall be overall lowest in clearance of air freight/sea freight consignments both in India and Afghanistan subject to fulfillment of other conditions of tender.
- 15. Bids of firms who have not executed any contact satisfactorily, failed to execute any such contract have/poor tract record shall not be considered. Misrepresentation or suppression of acts will lead to cancellation of the bid and forfeiture of the EMD.
- 16. Except where otherwise provided in the clauses of this contract or the execution of the same arriving during the progress of work after the completion, abandonment thereof all

disputes shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director General, ICAR and if he is unable or unwilling to act, to the sole arbitration of other person appointed by him willing to act as an arbitrator. The submission shall be deemed to be submission arbitration under the meaning of the Arbitration Act 1940 or any statutory modification of re-enactment thereof for the time being in force. The award of arbitrator so appointed shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to this contract.

- 17. All disputes to be settled under New Delhi Jurisdiction.
- 18. In case of any confusion, the parties should seek clarification about terms and conditions and pattern of formats, instead of quoting in ambiguous manner.
- 19. Firm should also be registered with the Indian Customs. Sister concerns/Authorized Party Certificate shall not be acceptable.
- 20. CHA must be registered in Custom House, Delhi and Mumbai.
- 21. The bidder should have facility for custom clearance at Mumbai and Delhi for air/sea cargo.
- 22. Rates should be quoted as per BOQ 1 and BOQ 2 online.
