1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to



SPECIFICATIONS FOR FLOW CYTOMETER WITH ACCESSORIES

1. System should have two lasers (488nm, 405nm) or more and able to detect a minimum of 4 fluorescence colors and 6 parameters or better including Forward (FSC) and Side Scatter (SSC).
2. If the system is two laser based, it should be upgradable to more lasers for meeting future needs.
3. Avalanche PhotoDiode (APD) or PhotoMultiplier Tube (PMT) detector based system.
4. The System should have high-quality quartz flow cell.
5. The minimum detectable particle size should be 0.2um or better.
6. Ability to perform submicron particle analysis of 0.1um or better (to detect exosomes, vesicles etc).
7. The System should be able to acquire at least 25,000 events per second or more.
8. System should offer user adjustable flow rate ranging 10ul- 60ul or better.
9. System should accept sample tube size of 1.5ml / 2ml / 5ml or 8.5 x 45 mm / 12 x 75 mm / 17 x 100 mm. Additional plate loader for 96 well plate is preferred.
10. Operational at 100-240 V/VAC and 150-250W.
11. With compatible computer with monitor for viewing the result and analyzing data.
12. Compatible analytical software with.
13. High efficiency with superior sensitivity less than 80, 30 and 70 MESF for FITC, PE and APC, respectively or better.
14. Accurate fluorescent detection with Co-efficient of variation <3%
15. Warranty of the system should be 2 years. The company should also provide AMC for at least 2 years along with the warranty.
16. The company should ensure proper installation of the equipment and provide technical assistance and training post installation.
17. The company should have proven experience in supply of similar equipment and aftersales service track record in India.
18. Live demonstration can be asked (if required) at Division of Genetics, ICAR-IARI, new Delhi before placing order.
