


Bids shall be submitted online only at GeM Portal at <a href="https://www.gem.gov.in">https://www.gem.gov.in</a>. Manual bids are strictly not accepted under any circumstances. GeM system ensures locking on the scheduled date and time. The system will not accept any bid after the scheduled date and time of submission of bid.

The Tender Inviting Authority has all the rights to retender or cancel the tender at any stage without mentioning the reasons.

Tenderer / Contractor are advised to follow the instructions carefully provided in **Instructions to Bidders (ITB) and General Condition of Contract (GCC)**, without fail, which are uploaded in our website at **iari.res.in** under "TENDER", before submission of your bid. Care has been taken to avoid contradiction between stipulation in the ITB, GCC and those in the other sections of the bidding documents. But wherever contradiction arises, if any, stipulations contained in the Schedule of Requirements shall prevail.

Tenderer / Contractor is also advised to follow the instructions provided in the 'Instructions to the Contractors/Tenderer for the submission of the bids online through the GeM Portal at 'https://www.gem.gov.in'

Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one firm or firms having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from the ICAR- IARI, Assam website <u>iari.res.in</u> or GeM Portal at <u>https://www.gem.gov.in</u> shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered / modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with ICAR- IARI, Assam.

Before the deadline for submission of the online bid, ICAR- IARI, Assam reserves the right to modify the tender document terms and conditions. #### **Prices:**

The price should be quoted in net per unit (after discount) and must include all packing and delivery charges to various Departments/Centers/Institutions of ICAR-IARI, Assam. The offer /bid should be exclusive of taxes and duties, which will be paid by the purchaser as applicable. However, the percentage of tax & duties should be clearly indicated.

#### **Risk Purchase Clause:**

In the event of failure of supply of the item/books within the stipulated delivery schedule, the purchaser has all the right to purchase the item/books from other sources on the total risk of the supplier under risk purchase clause.

#### **Submission of Tender**

- 1. The tender shall be submitted online in two part, viz., technical & financial/price bid.
- 2. All the pages of bid being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the bidder irrespective of nature of content of the documents before uploading.
- 3. The bids submitted through Post/Telegram/Fax/email shall not be considered and will be summarily rejected.
- 4. No correspondence will be entertained in this matter.
